GRAMMAR – Chicklets and EARLY BIRD

- Making lists – using commas to separate items on a list.
- Lily's Dog - use apostrophes to mark where letters are missing in spelling and to mark singular possession in nouns.
- Consonants and Vowel? – use of forms of a or an depending on whether the next word begins with a consonant or a vowel.
- Mark wants chicken – use of inverted commas to punctuate direct speech.
- The dog and the ball – use present perfect form of verbs instead of simple past tense.
